TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AGE

- Canadian applicants must be 16 years of age or older.
- International applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older.

CONSENT

- All applicants must sign and complete an online Liability Form Waiver before attending the Taste and See Programme.
- Students under the age of 19 must have their Liability Form signed by a parent/guardian also.

BIBLE SCHOOL INTEREST

- Applicants must have genuine interest in attending Bible School at Capernwray Harbour.
- Applicants may only apply if never before attended Taste and See.
- Applicants may only apply if never attended another Torchbearers School.

REFERENCE

- An application will not be considered complete until a pastoral reference has been received.

REFUND POLICY

- Payment of \$199.00 is non-refundable and non-transferable.

TIMETABLE

- All applicants are expected to attend and take part in every element of daily life, including attending classes, performing daily domestic duties, work day activities and engaging in presented outreach opportunities.
- Applicants are expected to complete the week applied for, beginning with Sunday Supper, and concluding following Friday Lunch.

CONDUCT

- All applicants will be expected to give full cooperation to the staff and administration of Capernwray Harbour Bible Centre.
- Applicants are not allowed in or around the student accommodations of the other sex, as these are considered bedroom areas.
- Curfew for applicants to be in their assigned accommodation will be 10:30PM with lights out at 11:00PM.
- Applicants are to abstain from promoting and engaging in premarital or extra marital sexual involvement or behaviour, including viewing, distributing or creating pornographic material.
- The use of tobacco/marijuana products (including e-cigarettes), alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are strictly forbidden for legal, moral and spiritual reasons. It is expected that Taste and See Guests will abstain from these for the duration of their stay.
